



Grant Conditions

By accepting the grant, you are agreeing to the following:

- Projects must contribute to tackling one or more of the priorities listed above
- Projects must primarily benefit residents of Frome Vale ward
- Priority will be given to applications from un-constituted resident led groups
- The maximum grant bid is £1000, however, you will be expected to consider that many people will be applying for the funds and the committee would like the money to have as wide an impact as possible
- You confirm that to the best of your knowledge the information in your application and supporting documentation is correct
- Grants will have to be spent by the end of April 2024. Any unspent monies will be expected to be returned. You may also be able to apply for an extension
- There may be some basic monitoring information required from successful applicants including evidence of how the money is spent (i.e. receipts - more information will be provided once grants are approved)
- You will need to complete an end of grant report which will include pictures and an impact statement
- To acknowledge Bristol Charities and Bristol City Council and the Grassroots Grant scheme in all publicity relating to this grant (e.g. press releases) and to co-operate with publicising the grant in, for example, the local media
- To use both the Bristol Charities and Bristol City Council logo on all printed publicity connected to the grant (e.g. posters, leaflets, flyers)
- Please note, if you provide photos or film footage as evidence of the use of the grant, we may use them in our own publicity materials unless you have asked us not to do so.
